Services during the period of social isolation

We are expecting to resume services in church in the near future (currently under review). For the time being we will continue to hold combined services **online** for the congregations of St Leonard's Rodney Stoke, St Peter's Draycott and St Andrew's Cheddar.

From Mondays to Fridays, we have online Evening Prayer at 8:30 p.m., and on Saturdays at 10 a.m. (using liturgies $\underline{1}$ or $\underline{2}$). This lasts about 20 minutes, after which we have a period in which we can chat and socialise. On Sundays, we have an online service at 10 a.m. On alternating Sundays this will be a service of Holy Communion, during which the president will receive communion on behalf of us all (and the services will be slightly longer, about 45 minutes). This will be followed again by a chance to chat, when we go into separate groups and take a bit longer.
